Once you are logged into the EBSCO databases, you may create your personal folder, which allows you to save searches and results to a folder to access at a later time.

- Choose a database from the list

- Fill out info
- Choose username (This can be anything you like. You may use your student ID. Be sure to write it down, as library staff cannot retrieve your user name)
- Choose password
- Click SAVE

Helpful tips:

- Narrow your searches by including a time frame (date of publication), format (periodical, book, image) and or adding more key words.
- Resources are available in the following formats:
Periodicals, books, primary source documents, academic journals, radio and TV transcripts, maps, encyclopedia articles, pictures, full text literature classics, and literary criticisms
- If you get too many results, add more key terms (i.e sharks—hammerhead shark)
- If you get too few results, broaden your search (Alaskan king salmon conservation policies --- salmon conservation)
- Use Boolean Operators of AND or NOT to get more specific results. (California AND Gold Rush= California Gold Rush; Cowboys NOT Football= removes all the results which have both words)
Use Boolean Operator OR to get more results. (Nixon and Watergate OR Impeach will give you results that have Nixon and info about Watergate or his impeachment.)
- You may print, email and save articles from the database.
- Utilize the citation tools to place necessary info into your works cited page. EBSCO provides 9 different citation styles including MLA, Chicago and APA.
- Some full text classics are available to download in the Literary Reference Center.
- Video tutorials are available from EBSCO via the EBSCO Support Site lined at the bottom of most pages.
- Many articles may be translated into Spanish
- Many articles are available in an audio format
